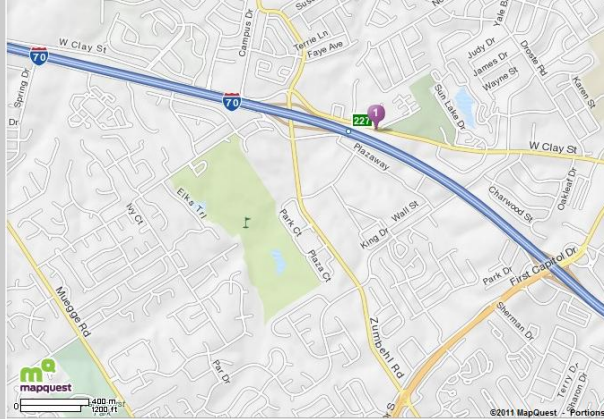
**Meeting Schedule**
