


Meeting Schedule

Meeting Minutes

June Meeting Minutes (6/12/2019)

The June meeting was called to order at Mark Twain Hobby Shop on 6/12/2019 by our President, Richard Jenkins.

Roll Call – There were 11 members present, we have 40 members total. No new members this month.

Treasurers Report - Our Treasurer, Jim Benedict, gave the treasurers report. There was a motion to approve.

Secretary's report – approved.

Safety report – none.

Field report –We anticipate our field will be covered with lots of debris, silt, corn cobs, etc. as it is still completely flooded. We will most likely have to replace the boards in the pavilion and power wash it. We may go with a mobile service. We will most likely replace the frequency board and the medicine cabinet. During the flood of 1993, the whole pavilion lifted up and floated away. Recent flood predictions for Winfield show water levels going down. If we're lucky, it will be the end of July before we can get back on the field. Owner said we won't have to pay him lease. We may if we can get on the field. Tractor remains in the storage facility. Bill took out the sprayer. There was concern about the water container floating around and damaging the roof. We will most likely have to replace the roof. May have to hire the roof job out.

Member Jim Plonka had a brain aneurism. A broken blood vessel caused serious bleeding. The doctors put a drain in his head to relieve blood build up. Frank Eck talked to him and he seemed concerned. Frank saw Jim when he is lucid. We agreed to send him a card, and pray for him. At meeting time, Jim was supposed to be at to the rehab facility there at DePaul. He was weak, and walking with a walker.

Also, at meeting time, we received a call from the daughter (Evan) of long-time member Benny Boisseau. She wanted someone to come over and look at his airplane equipment. Prez mentioned the St. Louis RC Trade Facebook where they can advertise for Sell or Trade. Prez was thinking about using them to get rid of his stuff. Former member, Dan Dierking, assisted with equipment appraisals and selling in the past.

East Side RC club gave us a month of temporary flying, which wouldn't be enough. Phantom Flyers was underwater at meeting time. Road was initially cut off.

Old business – Jim Benedict mentioned that we are waiting on an IRS statement stating that we are a non-profit organization before accounts can be changed to reflect the name change of the club. Doug Sanders will also have to register the new name with the AMA.

New business –Prez attended a Warbird Fly-in in Mattoon Illinois, Mattoon is north of Effingham. Prez flew a P40. He had difficulty with the landing gear. He mentioned that he made a hard belly landing. Prez has to give full right rudder to take it off. He has to land hot, with the gear on the ground before he cuts throttle. Prez said it's the most difficult plane to fly that he has ever built. Prez talked about Tom Duncan, a longtime modeler who has several kits available. He has three buildings (yes, three buildings) filled with planes and engines. He's a warbird guy.
